



Postback Methodology

Annulments:

The annulment of an existing Transmission Reservation removes that reservation from consideration as an Existing Transmission Commitment (ETC) in the ATC calculation.

Redirect on a Firm Basis:

A redirect of firm transmission service removes the redirected portion from the capacity of the original reservation. The calculated ATC will reflect any reduction in the reserved capacity.

Recalled Capacity:

Recalled capacity reduces the ETC used in the calculation of ATC. This will make previously reserved capacity available.

Unscheduled Firm Capacity:

Unscheduled firm capacity is released to non-firm AFC when only the scheduled capacity of a firm reservation is included in an Existing Transmission Commitment (ETC). Therefore, a separate Postback value is not needed in the calculation.
