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## MAPP Procedure for Processing Transmission Services Requests on the WAUE-SPC Contract Path

## Effective 12:00 Noon, 04/12/2008

This is the MAPP procedure for submitting requests for transmission service to or from the following Point of Receipt (POR) or Point of Delivery (POD) on the MAPP OASIS:

• WAUE.SPC

This procedure is designed to ensure that all transmission service requests are able to be quickly and accurately evaluated. This procedure affects requests for transmission service to the subject service point submitted between **12:00:00 noon and 12:05:00 p.m. Central Time**.

If more than five (5) requests are submitted by the same <u>Transmission Customer</u> or group of <u>Affiliated Transmission Customers</u> within the specified time period to the subject service point in aggregate, then all such requests shall be considered as invalid.

The Transaction Coordinator or Western Area Power Administration will set the status of all such invalid transmission requests to INVALID. (For example, six (6) requests to or from WAUE.SPC submitted between Noon and 12:05 p.m. CPT by the same <u>Transmission Customer</u> or group of <u>Affiliated Transmission Customers</u> would have ALL six (6) set to INVALID.)
