

Public notice of contractual conversion between Public Service Company of Colorado (PSCo) and Western Area Power Administration (WAPA)

WAPA is converting its existing contract no. 88-LAO-376 providing firm transmission service to Network Integration Service with PSCo effective Dec. 1, 2013. The provisions of the contract stipulate the transmission of power and energy at points of interconnection and delivery between the Loveland Area Projects (LAP), Colorado River Storage Project (CRSP), and PSCo; PSCo provides transmission service on a firm basis to WAPA's Designated Network Load customers.

WAPA, as a Network Customer of PSCo, is assigned confirmed Transmission Service provided by PSCo on WAPA's behalf to enable WAPA to schedule to their Designated Network Load customers, as well as enable PSCo to appropriately decrement transmission paths ATC. This assignment will occur through Transmission Service Requests (TSR).

The assigned POR/POD and magnitude of the TSR is determined by the Designated Network Resource (DNR) and Designated Network Loads geographical and electrical proximity to existing PSCo Point of Receipt (POR) and /PODs and interconnection points between the LAP and CRSP transmission systems. The firm transmission service conversion is based upon existing contract no. 88-LAO-376 DNL Points of Delivery and magnitude.
