#### B. Details

System will refer to Transmission Line facilities by 'From Sub' to 'To Sub' 'Voltage Level' in all oral and written communication when dealing with both internal and external parties. When dealing with multiple lines that would have the same name a circuit number identifier would be used thus making each identifier unique.

All substation equipment in Tri-State Generation and Transmission Association substations will be numbered according to SOP #14 ensuring that all equipment identifiers are unique and consistent throughout the system.
