Tri-State Generation and Transmission Association, Inc. holds great value in the relationships that we share with our Network Transmission Customers, and we feel it is our duty to provide the best customer service possible by effectively communicating any and all applicable changes. In 2016, the process for completing Network Integrated Transmission Service (NITS) applications, including any associated load(s), resources and transmission rights, will be changing throughout the industry. The new NITS application process will be similar to the existing Transmission Service Request (TSR) method that utilizes the OASIS. The upcoming NITS change was first proposed within FERC Order 890, and more recently reiterated in FERC Order 676-H. Within FERC Order 676-H, FERC officially approved the “NITS on OASIS” proposition by referencing the Version 003 NEASB Standards.

The Tri-State OASIS personnel intend to work alongside our Network Transmission Customers throughout the implementation phase to create a smooth and beneficial transition to the NITS on OASIS. The Tri-State Network Transmission Customers will also have the opportunity for individual training and guidance (from the Tri-State OASIS personnel) regarding the NITS on OASIS functionality.

To ensure the most efficient communication, we ask that all Tri-State Network Transmission Customers provide a primary point of contact who will be involved in building your organization’s NITS on OASIS environment. As indicated below, please provide the following information for the primary point of contact in your organization: name, email address, and phone number. Tri-State looks forward to helping of each of our Network Transmission Customer’s in an effort to make the transition to the NITS on OASIS a seamless and successful one.
