Western Area Power Administration (WAPA) respectfully submits this request to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) to grant WAPA's requested effective date of February 1, 2021 as detailed in its Transmittal Letter, and requests it disregard the incorrect metadata date of December 2, 2020 in the eTariff electronic filing package.

DESCRIPTION OF ERRATA

While the transmittal letter WAPA submitted on December 2, 2020 correctly requested the effective date of February 2, 2021, the eTariff electronic filing package individual record metadata reflects an incorrect effective date of December 2, 2020.

Using the effective date of February 2, 2021 as outlined in the original transmittal letter rather than December 2, 2020 will not harm any WAPA transmission customer, and will align the effective date of WAPA's tariff changes with the expected go-live date of the WEIS Market.

CONCLUSION

WAPA requests the Commission accept the original filing and retain the original submittal date of December 2, 2020 for the filing and approve WAPA's proposed tariff effective date of February 1, 2021. WAPA apologizes for any inconvenience this error may have caused.
