

Notice: Western Area Power Administration (WAPA) proposes revisions to its Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT) to address the necessary delay in compliance with FERC Order 881 (*Managing Transmission Line Ratings*).

(OATT Revision 24-01, Order 881 Compliance Date Extension)

November 26, 2024

WAPA is proposing OATT Revision 24-01 to update the Effective Date of Attachment U (Transmission Line Ratings) from July 12, 2025, to October 2, 2028, to address the necessary delay in **FERC Order 881** compliance for WAPA's CRSP, DSW, RMR, and SN Regions.

The necessary delay in Order 881 compliance for WAPA's CRSP, DSW, RM, and SN regions is a result of WAPA's statutory limitations, and therefore, WAPA did not identify the need to hold an information meeting to present the proposed 24-01 OATT revisions to stakeholders, or to request comments. WAPA's filing letter to FERC outlines the reasons for the necessary delay in Order 881 compliance, and WAPA's proposed new compliance date of October 2, 2028. WAPA encourages interested parties to monitor for OATT Revision 24-01 status updates on WAPA's OASIS.

The OATT Revision 24-01 redlines were posted on WAPA's OASIS on November 26, 2024. **Only the Effective Date of Attachment U is changed**. Attachment U was previously added to the WAPA OATT under OATT Revision 22-02 and accepted by FERC under Docket No. EF23-5-000 on June 12, 2024.

WAPA plans to file the proposed WAPA OATT change (i.e., update the Effective Date of Attachment U from July 12, 2025, to October 2, 2028) with FERC on December 6, 2024.
