



## About wesTTrans.net

wesTTrans.net is an enhanced OASIS site comprised of over 30 Members which collectively represent a significant portion of the Western Interconnection. Each participating Transmission Provider (Member) maintains their own Open-Access Transmission Tariff (OATT), but collectively they provide a common and efficient method of enhancing the transmission market within the Western Power Grid. From this single market interface, access to nearly all transmission within the West can be obtained.

Several resources are posted on wesTTrans.net to assist new Transmission Customers in understanding the affiliation of the wesTTrans Members and their associated transmission facilities. The [wesTTrans Transmission Map](#) illustrates an overview of the transmission facilities for which the wesTTrans Members represent. The [wesTTrans Participant Map](#), shown on the wesTTrans.net Home Page, provides a regional overview of the Members and hyper-links to each Member's information. The [wesTTrans Members' Contact List](#) gives names and contact information for each specific Transmission Provider. And, the wesTTrans Outages report provides a summary of the facility outages posted by the Transmission Providers. The Outage report is viewable to webSmartOASIS authorized users only.

The webSmartOASIS™ system was developed by Open Access Technology International, Inc. (OATI) to provide Open Access Same-time Information System (OASIS) services to the deregulated Energy Industry. Access to the system is obtained through [Registration](#) with OATI, the OASIS node service provider and system administrator.

The wesTTrans webSmartOASIS™ system provides several important enhanced [Features](#) for Transmission Customers including a Multi-Provider Query functionality, a Multi-Provider Deal automation system, an Energy Bulletin Board, and a Secondary Market Resale interface.

The wesTTrans Transmission Providers have configured a Demo OASIS system with access to all the enhanced OASIS features to help facilitate customer training and familiarization with new system enhancements. Both the [Demo OASIS](#) system and the [Production OASIS](#) system require user accounts to be registered through the OATI OASIS Registration process.
